Final Approval/Promulgation

- Disaster Volunteer Management - Currently in the legal review stage and receiving approval signatures shortly.

Plan Development

- Air Quality Annex Draft in progress and review by partners.
- **Disaster Housing Recovery** The rough draft is in progress and continuing to add content based on partner feedback, including the Disaster Housing Task Force.
- **Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)** Held multiple ESF workshops to review specific components, drafted the initial structure of the base plan, and continuing to update and incorporate new changes.
- **Evacuation** Continuing to revise components of the plan.
- Extreme Temperature Providing seasonal updates and review by partners.
- **Fixed Nuclear Facility** The state deadline has been extended until Spring 2024. A plan reform was conducted and will begin incorporating partner's feedback.
- Migrant Sheltering Draft in progress and review by partners.
